## A CHALLENGING YEAR

Gosh – what an upheaval our beloved Station Square is going through! Watching its reconstruction take place through the summer, and now the fall, has been fascinating. We are happy to report that communications with the Forest Hills Gardens Corporation during this process have been ongoing as our officers have been kept “in the loop” while plans for the Square move forward. We are thrilled, and hope you are as well, to see the center island return to its earlier configuration with “two cut-throughs.”

Obviously we were not able to plant our usual plethora of annuals in the center island this year. However, several members of the Board donned their gardening gloves one wet

weekend in May and planted over one hundred pink petunias and lantana along the walkway and stairway leading to the Long Island Rail Road Station. I think you will agree that they thrived beautifully there (see center photo). The roses in the planters along the entrance to Greenway Terrace also did well but, alas, they were almost totally obscured by the construction fencing.

## ONGOING MAINTENANCE COSTS

Many of our regular expenses have continued throughout this year even while the Square is undergoing restoration. Recognizing that it would

be unwise to skimp on any landscaping work, Rocco Parente’s crew has continued their monthly maintenance on the LIRR embankment. The sprinkler system continued to take care of the watering needs there but, unfortunately, it has also continued to show signs of its age and required further costly repairs in the summer. This has


meant that our annual expenditures have not been very different from those of previous years and we must once again ask you, our loyal “Friends,” to help us meet expenses.
